# TIME AND DATE

- The conference day will be held on Friday, August 27th, 2021.
- The conference day will be held from 09.00 until 17.00 (GMT+7, Western Indonesian Time).
- The participants can enter Zoom from 08.00 (GMT+7, Western Indonesian Time).
- The conference day schedule can be seen at the next chapter of this guidelines.
- For participants who take part in the competition are required to attend all series of conferences from the beginning.





# PLATFORM

- The conference will be separated for each field of interest.
- The conference will be held using Zoom platform.
- The conference room link can be seen at the next chapter of this guidelines.
- The participants and audiences Zoom name account must match the name shown on the registration form.
- The participants and audiences are expected to turn on their camera and use the background provided by IYSRE.
- During the course of the conference, participants and audiences must turn off the microphone except when they are permitted to ask questions in QnA sessions and presentations by the moderator.

# PRESENTATION

1. Each group can be represented by one of the group members or all group members.
2. Each member of the presenting group should be present and turn on their camera.
3. The duration of the presentation is 15 minutes including QnA session.
4. The presentation is on live streaming session.
5. The presenter must use English as the main language of the presentation.
6. There are audiences in the room.
7. The QnA session can be given by the reviewer and the audience.
8. Questions can be given through the chat section in the Zoom.
9. The powerpoint will be presented by the committee in the related breakout room.
10. If there are any late groups, they will be rescheduled.

# PRESENTATION SLIDE

1. Each group must make a powerpoint presentation.
2. Each presentation consists of 10 maximum slides, excluding the opening and the closing slides.
3. The powerpoint must be submitted by August 21, 2021 at 23.59 (GMT+7, Western Indonesian Time).

# TOR ABSTRACT AND PAPER WRITING

## 1) Abstract Writing Requirements and Guidelines :

- Abstract consists of 200-300 words written in English. They include the essence of the proposed idea and solution, consist background, supporting data, objectives and methods, and an overview of the solutions
- The abstract consists of original ideas made by participants and never has submitted/published in other competitions.
- The abstract is written on a provide paper template in <http://conference.iysre.com/>
- The abstract is written in Times New Roman font with a size of 12, with a line spacing of 1.15
- he maximum keywords stated in abstract are four keywords.

## 2) Paper Writing Requirements and Guidelines :

- The paper is written in Times New Roman font with a size of 12, with a line spacing of 1.15 on a provide paper template in <http://conference.iysre.com/>
- The paper is written based on the abstract that the team had submitted before and consists of original ideas made by participants and never has submitted/published in other competitions
- The paper is written in 6 parts :
  - 1.Introduction: Consist of the summarizes of the problem, background that outlines the literature review of the research, the purpose of the research, the importance and the benefits of the research
  - 2.Literature Review: Consist all the past studies conducted in line with the research, the relevance of the literature on the research, advantages or weakness of the existing work related to the research.
  - 3.Methodology: Set of tools and techniques that are used to conduct the research. It has to describe which approach/methodologies are adapted in this research, and why these are selected over others, and how these are applied in the research
  - 4.Results and Discussion: Consist of description about the main findings of a research, whereas the discussion section interprets the results for readers and provides the significance of the findings.
  - 5.Conclusion: Provide a brief description of the scientific result and the advantages of the research,
  - 6.Recommendation: Provide the scientific contribution of the research within the field with future research directions.
- References, Table, and Figure is written based on the provide paper template.
